This event is dedicated to Gary by students and friends who want to honor Gary and to particularly thank him for his dedication to teaching bridge. Gary first played bridge at eleven years old in the family kitchen and continued at home until he left home for College Station. While at college, Gary began his teaching career, often reading chapter three, while teaching chapter two! After graduating from Texas A&M with a degree in mechanical engineering from, Gary moved to Houston and directed and taught bridge at the Bridge and Games Studio from '86-'90. In 1987, in conjunction with Alcatel- a French video terminal company- Gary ran the first computer generated world-wide simultaneous pairs. The same hands were played at the same time at the B&G Studio of Houston and two clubs in Paris and scored across-the-field. Gary has authored hundreds of articles for the newer player many in "The Bridge Companion" newsletter, (a total of 63 issues for 10 years), and later in the I/ N column for seven years in the *District 16 Scorecard*.
