Larry Davis Wins 2011 Jacoby Award

Larry Davis has tirelessly worked for the Austin unit and District 16 for many years having served as District 16 president and Unit 207's district representative. He has chaired or co-chaired every Austin regional since 1996 and chaired or co-chaired numerous sectional and limited point sectional events. He has served on the unit board, been a tournament coordinator, served on the nominating committee, been the NAP coordinator, and is the long time editor of our unit newsletter.

Larry has been a go to guy for Unit 207 when we have to move supplies to tournament sites and has negotiated marvelous contracts for tournaments which has saved many thousands of dollars and allowed Austin to offer lower tournament entry fees than most major cities.

Larry started our 0-100 tournaments (now 0-200) which have been successful in introducing new players to bridge tournaments. When these tournaments first started, Larry directed the tournaments and agreed to reduce his fee if needed to be sure they didn't lose money for the unit. He encouraged the unit to sponsor mentoring programs for new players. He started a new senior citizen game in South Austin and is currently working on a non life master regional in Austin. He started a liaison program for outlying clubs in the unit and this one reason our unit has grown.

Larry Davis has worked tirelessly for the growth and betterment of bridge in Austin and throughout our District and we're proud to announce that he is the recipient of the 2011 Jacoby Award.

As many of you already know, convincing your spouse to learn bridge can be quite the challenge. Donna Patton, who had just completed Easybridge 1, managed to get her husband John to join us (for this alone she deserves much credit). Along came Barbara and Winford Whittaker wanting to learn too. Little did the three of them know that as soon as they could count to 13, they'd be thrown in with Donna's group on game night, sink or swim. They may have started at a disadvantage but they are catching up very quickly! We're delighted they stuck with it.

During one of our workshops, we heard the most original responses to 4NT (blackwood) from one of our new players Janet, pronounced Janette. She never misses a session and seems to enjoy the game very much except for one thing, NT. She does not like to bid or play it and will do whatever she needs to do to get out of it. Her partner for the evening, Bob, is just the opposite. He'll skip over a 1H or 1S up-the-line response to go straight to NT. They had never

played as partners before, so the pair promised to be very entertaining. Here's how the bidding went – Janet has a balanced hand, 15-17 pts and opens a minor. Since it was workshop night, we reviewed the opening bid and she corrected it to 1NT. Bob has a powerhouse and 5 hearts so he bids 2D (transfer). Not yet clear where this was all headed, she accepts transfer with 2H's in her hand. Bob confidently bids 4NT and Janet's expression immediately went from unclear to oh-no-not-slam-in-NT! She turned to me with that lovely and mischievous smile of hers and I said, "He just wants to know how many aces you have," to which she replied with a slight huff and a puff, "well, I think that's none of his business!!". After much laughter, they reached their 6NT contract. Janet played it beautifully and made. Great job!

The joint is jumping in Unit 201 and the Beaumont Bridge Club. They have 4 mini/lesson games scheduled each week.
