#### Paul Cuneo Wins Oswald and James Jacoby Award



Paul Cuneo retired from Shell Oil Company in 2002 after a 33 year career. In Paul's last position, he was Chief Information Officer for Shell Oil Products Company. In this position he was responsible for all Information Technology for the company and reported to the CEO. Paul holds a Chemical and Petroleum Refining Engineer degree from Colorado School of Mines. Paul has lived in Houston since 1990.

Paul was elected to the Unit 174 ACBL Board in April, 2008 and served as President twice during his 6 year term. He began co-chairing the Lone Star Regional in 2010 where the attendance passed 3000 tables for the first time

since 1999. In 2011, Gold Rush Pairs and Bracketed Swiss team events were first played at the Lone Star Regional and event times were revised. These changes have been popular with players and the LSR increased attendance to 3259.5 tables in 2013. For the first time, the Unit 174 had 4 consecutive years of over 3000 tables in attentive

Paul is now the Unit 174 Representative on the District 16 Board. In 2013 Paul served as Second Vice-President of the District 16 Board and is currently serving as the First Vice-President. In addition to volunteering at ESCH, Paul volunteers with Between Jobs Ministry at Northwest Bible Church where is is a Deacon and serves on the Bilma PUD Board.



(I hate that word, but their bidding, declarer play and defense did indeed inspire awe). ## A Captain's Tale from Wroclaw

As Im sure you already know the US women won the 2016 world championship in Wroclaw (pronounced "Vratswaf"), Poland. Tobi was on the team and I wascaptain. Last year, I captained Tobis silver-medal team in India. Lest you have any doubt, it feels *much* better to win the gold than tobe runner-up!

The world championships are grueling. To make the finals, you play for 14 days behind screens, so bidding takes longer than usual; you have to move the tray back and forth through the small opening until the bidding e n d s , then remove the tray. Also, there is no oral communication. All questions have to be asked and answered in writing. Because the stakes are so high, you cant lose focus for an instant. By day's end, players are exhausted; it's a quick dinner, then bed.

People assume being captain is like being on vacation. Far from it. Be

fore we left, I copied the convention cards of the 16 teams in our round robin bracket plus the 5 teams in the other bracket we'd likely meet if we made it to the KO phase. Total: 441 convention cards (21 teams x 3 pairs x 7 copies)--and WBF cards can be 20 pages long! I highlighted unusual conventions and compiled a defense database. I helped players with travel arrangements and drug testing. Say what? The World Bridge Federation follows Olympic drug protocol; bridge players are subject to the same restrictions as Olympic athletes! If you take a drug on the proscribed list (90 pages long), you must explain why and apply for an exemption. I also had the sad job of finding a replacement for Juanita Chambers, who passed away a month before the event.

In Wroclaw, I had to arrange for a taxi to take players to-and-from the venue 3miles a way, make sure players were on time, determine who played each match, handle appeals, shop for snacks, deal with hotel snafus, make dinner reservations, serve as a sounding board,

Make your plans to play in the NAP District finals in Austin, January 7 and 8. Roxie Tom, the D16 NAP Coordinator, reports District 16 will receive enhanced subsidies to Nationals in Flights B and C for the 2016-2017 North American Pairs in Kansas City, MO.

There will be three pairs from A, four from B and four from flight C who will qualify to represent District 16 at the Kansas City Spring Nationals in March. The district is adding money to the amount ACBL

awards. The total stipends for each qualifying player in each pair are as follows:

**Flight A:** 1st \$800 2nd \$500 3rd \$300 **Flight B:** 1st \$800 2nd \$800 3rd

\$500 4th \$300 **Flight C**: 1st \$800 2nd \$800 3rd \$500 4th \$300

In addition to financial stipends for the top finishers, all the participants enjoy the best competition available on the district calendar. Any members who qualify to go to the nationals, check with your unit to see if they provide a stipend.

Many thanks to all the Unit Coordinators for helping to promote this great event. As the District finals approach, each Unit coordinator is allowed to make substitutions up to 60% of their field, so if you failed to qualify in your Unit final, there is still hope if a pair ahead of you drops. Stay in contact with your Unit coordinator.



Wow! Congratulations to all!

Fundamental Tip: What do you think your partner is asking you to do when you are dealer and the bidding goes Pass-Pass-Pass-7 Spades-Pass-Pass-Double-Pass-Pass-Pass? You are on lead against this 7S contract your partner has doubled. Partner is about to turn blue from holding his breath that you will figure it out. What is your first instinct? It should be clear that Partner has a void and at least one spade, and that you should be able to defeat this contract if you lead his void. George Rosencranz wrote a book many years ago that has stood the test of time and is a great tool today, called Trump Leads. I strongly recommend it to any level player. He describes this hand and tells us the double is a "Lightner Double," which asks Partner to make an unusual lead against a slam. It was developed by New York City's Theodore Lightner for lead directing against a slam. You look through your fairly meaningless hand and note a sixcard heart suit to the 10. Wouldn't that be your best shot to hit Partner's void? As things turned out, it was correct, Partner was void in hearts, and the contract went down 1. The 7-Spade bidder had A-K-Q-J -10-9 of Spades, A-K-Q of Hearts, A of Diamonds, and A-K-O of Clubs. (Heavy sigh.) From Feast to Famine, in one fell swoop.
