

Known as "Gunner" to his many friends, Earnest Virgil Willhelm, Jr. passed away May 30, 2017 at the age of 88. Gunner was an active and beloved member of the San Antonio bridge community since moving to the city in 2000. A native of Galveston, Gunner earned a degree in accounting from the University of Texas in 1948. He served as an officer in the Air Force during the Korean War, and held overseas assignments in Japan and Okinawa before returning to the accounting profession. Working for Exxon, Gunner had positions in Europe, Libya, New York and Los Angeles before retiring in 1982. In retirement, Gunner traveled widely, both in the U.S. and internationally, while simultaneously sharpening his skills in his beloved game of bridge. In 1986, he qualified for the World Championship Bridge Tournament in Bal Harbor, Florida. The San Antonio bridge community will fondly remember Gunner and his warmth, friendliness, good humor and unfailing courtesy to partners and opponents alike. Gunner, we miss

The Unit 172 Board of Directors is pleased to name an event for Doug Cross in recognition of his wise counsel and ongoing generosity.

For many years, the Unit rented a storage unit to house its 160 card tables, 30 sets of boards, hundreds of bidding boxes and many boxes of supplies. Loading and unloading the necessary equipment and supplies into a rented truck several times a year was no easy chore. Doug came up with a suggestion which cut the workload in half and saved the Unit thousands of dollars: buy a storage trailer. Doug had his skilled employees customize the interior of the trailer to maximize its utility. For years he loaned us a truck to haul the trailer. Eventually he gave us the truck but continues to provide its maintenance. He stores the truck and trailer on his business property.

Doug's contributions to Unit 172, while greatly appreciated, are only a small part of his overall philanthropic impact in the broader San Antonio community. He has provided leadership and raised millions of dollars to benefit the Lighthouse for the Blind, Child-Safe, Central Catholic High School, St. Mary's University, Hope for the Future, and Rotarian efforts to promote community access to water in Honduras.

Brenda is a gracious, delightful partner and opponent. She has spent a lifetime playing the game of bridge and is proud to have accumulated 644.79 points.


