Laurie Levin

Stratified 299er Pairs (Saturday 2:30pm) Stratified Swiss (Tuesday 7pm and Wednesday 7pm)

Laurie came to us from South Africa (for those of you who have noticed her slightly non-Texas accent!) She and her husband, Larry, fled with their sons from the country's harsh apartheid regime, choosing San Antonio as their new home.

Now an ABTA Master Teacher, she began teaching bridge in 1986 and has taught in various venues around San Antonio, including at the former Turtle Creek Duplicate Bridge Club, the Jewish Community Center, in private homes and other locales. Her bridge mentor was her father, Bertie Broer, a real bridge mavin, who represented South Africa in World Bridge tournaments. As her bridge friends will tell you, she is especially noted for her friendly and enthusiastic manner with all players, both new and old. She encourages novices and supports her bridge peers.

Now Laurie brings her enthusiasm for the game and her hospitality to her own club, Fiesta Bridge Club. It's San Antonio's only public club and offers open games at 11am Monday through Saturday, 1:30 pm on Sundays and 7pm on Tuesdays ("Bridge Express"). For newer players there are 499er games at 7pm on Thursdays (with a free lesson at 6:30pm) and 11am on Wednesdays. There's also a popular 299er game at 1pm on Tuesdays. Laurie, along with other nationally recognized teachers, offers lessons for all levels of play, for groups and individuals. She is a great ambassador for bridge, so if you haven't met her, introduce yourself and let her introduce you to bridge, Fiesta-style! South Africa's loss - our gain!



Hank Eng Gold Rush Pairs (Tuesday 9:30am and 2:30pm)

Unit 172 is lucky to have Hank Eng as a member. When you hear Hank's name, you think "great player." However, his best attributes are his laughter and his willingness to help.
