Strati-Flighted Swiss:
A: 4000+ AX: 0-4000 B: 0-2000 C: 0-750 D: 0-300
(A & AX play together, B, C & D play together)

NOTE: Stratification is based on average MPs for each pair/team; however, for Strati-Flighted events, qualification to play in a given flight is determined by the maximum MP holding for any player on that pair/team.
